Purpose: GAGAL's Working Safely at Heights course is designed to gain the necessary skills to plan, prepare and complete work that has a risk of injury from falling from heights. Participants gain knowledge in the use of anchor points, harnesses and associated equipment and the force generated through falling. On completion of this course, participants will be able to correctly fit a harness and be confident in working safely at heights. This qualification provides participants with a nationally accredited qualification (MNMG237A) outlined by the Australian Standards.
